

- 1 **City Hall Complex**
Centrally located and adjacent to the downtown, Milan's City Hall complex includes several historic buildings that are part of Henry Ford Village Industries, the public library, the police department, a community center, and Milan Seniors for Healthy Living.

- 4 **Milan Area Schools (Westside Campus)**
One of two school complexes in the City of Milan, this campus houses the district offices, the high school and an upper elementary school. The high school grounds include baseball diamonds, tennis courts, the football field, pools, gyms, and a state-of-the art theater that attract thousands of visitors from across the state and region annually.

The Milan School District serves households in both Washtenaw and Monroe Counties. The four school buildings that comprise the Milan Area School District operate as schools-of-choice facilities that serve 2,200 students ranging from preschool age to grade twelve.
- 5 **Nature Park**
Nature Park (19 acres) is situated on the Saline River. It features a kayak launch, playground, and pavilion with a fireplace.
- 6 **Kroger Plaza**
This busy shopping center is anchored by Kroger, the number one grocer by market share in the Ann Arbor area. Additional national and regional tenants include Edward Jones, Fiesta Salon and Ace Hardware.
- 7 **Draper Houston Meadows Preserve**
Just west of the city of Milan, the Draper-Houston Meadows Preserve (132 acres) protects over one-half mile of Saline River shoreline. At the preserve, you will encounter high-quality floodplain forest habitat with oak, walnut, butternut, and sycamore trees.
- 8 **Historic Downtown Milan**
Nestled alongside Ford Lake, historic downtown Milan evokes all the best of small-town life. A public square situated in the center of a two-block shopping and dining district provides a gathering place for people to connect and a space for events that attract residents and visitors.
- 9 **Milan Area Schools (Central Campus)**
One of two school complexes in the City of Milan, this complex is located near the downtown. The Middle School and a lower elementary school are located on this campus.
- 10 **Dexter Corridor**
Highly visible and easily accessible from US 23, the Dexter Corridor includes a mix of retail and restaurants and is the main connector to Edgetown and Downtown.
- 11 **Exit 27 on US 23**
One of two exits from US 23 with easy access to all businesses.
- 12 **FCI Milan**
FCI Milan is a low security federal correctional institution with a detention center that employs 300 people.
- 13 **Vern R. Campbell Park**
Vern R. Campbell Park features 41 acres of parkland that includes soccer fields (23 acres) and flying fields (18 acres) for remote control model aircrafts.
- 14 **Edgetown**
Located on the edge of downtown Milan and the Dexter corridor, Edgetown is home to Milk & Honey Bakery, Mutiny Coffee Roaster, and Orignal Gravity (OG) Brewing Company. It's an enclave of artisan food and beverage makers. The OG is widely recognized as one of Michgian's best brew pubs.
- 15 **Historic Hack House**
Once the home of a founding family of Milan, the Hack House now attracts visitors interested in the architecture, furnishings, and decorative objects of the late Victorian period. Four outbuildings (including a three-seat outhouse) and period gardens complete a pastoral picture of 19th-century life.
- 16 **Factories & Plants (Eastside)**
- 17 **Love's Travel Stop**
The nation's industry-leading travel stop network is located off U.S. Highway 23 in Milan. Love's employs 63 people and offers 93 truck and 83 car parking spaces.
- 18 **Exit 25 on US 23**
One of two exits from US 23 with easy access to all businesses.
- 19 **Old Fire Barn**
The beautifully restored historic building provides visitors with a stunning first impression of the downtown district.
- 20 **Ford Lake**
Ford Lake was created in the 1930s when Henry Ford constructed a dam on the Saline River and forever changed the geography of Milan. Today, the lake features a boardwalk with bump outs onto the water and bench swing perfect for watching sunrises and sunsets.
- 21 **Wilson Park**
Wilson Park (23 acres) is adjacent to the downtown and nestled along the Saline River and Ford Lake. The park includes a playground, brand new pavilion, baseball fields, walking paths, a Gaga Ball pit, and four holes of frisbee golf. Two arched bridges over the river and the scenic landscape make it a favorite location for weddings and photo ops.
